SUPERINTENDENT

With spring weather, we experience a surge of growth in the rough each year. The Staff has been out mowing daily trying to maintain it to expectations

During these times, it is extremely difficult to keep up with this surge of growth, particularly when we lose maintenance time to weather delays and equipment failure.

The subsurface greens drainage has continued to improve the overall health and performance of the greens after substantial rainfall in late winter and early spring. Aeration was performed April 9th-11th on greens/collars and approaches. Cores were pulled, roughly 80 tons of sand was used to fill holes and collars/approaches were seeded. A cold snap in weather was experienced shortly after completing this process slowing the recovery time.

Please help the crew maintain your course by repairing all ball marks and filling divots. Please rake bunkers after playing out of them as a courtesy to other players. Please check with Pro Shop for daily cart rules. We encourage you to drive carts 90 degrees across fairways and keep them in the rough as much as possible.

The cold overnight temperatures along with morning frost have delayed the Bermuda tees and fairways from greening up this spring. It is extremely tender during this transition period from dormancy to greening up and will not recover in a timely

manner. Please keep carts on path around greens and tees and run in rough as much as possible.
