Renovations Underway

As we move into the heart of summer, I want to thank our membership for your continued support and patience as we work through another challenging growing season. Mother Nature has certainly kept us on our toes this year, but our grounds crew remains committed to providing the best playing conditions possible. Every day, our team is focused on improving the golf course while balancing the long-term health of the turf with the daily expectations of play.

The biggest project currently underway is the complete renovation of the Hole #1 fairway using Tahoma 31 Bermudagrass sprigs. This installation was professionally completed by Grassmasters of Patoka, Indiana, utilizing one of the newest and most exciting bermudagrass varieties available. Developed by Oklahoma State University, Tahoma 31 has proven to be significantly more cold hardy while also producing a finer, denser playing surface than traditional bermudagrass varieties. We understand that keeping players off the fairway requires some patience, but this investment is one that will benefit the course for years to come. Over the next 60 to 90 days, the new sprigs will establish and mature, and we're confident the results will speak for themselves.

In addition to Hole #1, we continue making steady progress repairing the remaining winter-kill areas throughout the golf course. Our maintenance staff has been handling these repairs in-house through a combination of sprigging and sodding, allowing us to efficiently restore affected areas while minimizing disruption to play.



These improvements are all part of our ongoing commitment to strengthening the course and reducing the impact of future winter weather.

We're also excited to announce that our new SubAir Turf Fans are arriving, with installation scheduled to begin this month. These fans are designed to improve air movement across our putting surfaces, helping to both cool and dry the greens during the stressful summer months. By reducing heat stress and excess moisture, this technology will promote healthier turf and more consistent playing conditions throughout the season. As always, our grounds crew is working diligently to provide the best golf course possible, and we sincerely appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue investing in the long-term success of Sleepy Hollow Golf Club.
