Greens Healthy Despite Challenges

As we head into August, I'd like to provide an update on several projects around the golf course and the overall condition of the property. Our biggest focus continues to be the recovery of #1 fairway, where we are now 38 days removed from the sprigging application as of August 1. While our anticipated establishment timeline remains 60–90 days, we have been very encouraged by the progress so far. Most areas have developed a healthy stand of turf and are establishing well. There are still a few thin areas that have not filled in as quickly as we'd like, and our team has begun re-sprigging those sections to encourage additional growth and improve uniformity. We appreciate everyone's patience as the fairway continues to mature, and we remain confident it will continue to improve throughout the remainder of the growing season.

Another improvement underway is the installation of our new Turf Breeze fans. Fans have already been installed on greens at holes 3, 4, and 6, with the remaining units on holes 5 and 12 scheduled for installation after the necessary groundwork and trenching for new electrical service, which has already been completed. These fans will play a significant role in improving growing conditions by increasing air movement on greens that have historically experienced poor airflow. Better circulation helps reduce disease pressure, improves plant health, and provides valuable cooling during periods of intense summer heat. This investment will continue to strengthen the long-term health and consistency of our putting surfaces.

We look forward to seeing the course continue to improve as we move through the remainder of the summer.
