Greens & Grounds

No. 1 Fairway Update

As we move into September, I'm excited to share an update on the progress we've made around the golf course this summer. One of our biggest projects has been the No. 1 fairway, which was initially sprigged in late June. The new turf has established well, and we are on track to have the fairway open for play this September. We're very encouraged by its progress and expect the playing surface to continue improving as the new turf matures.

During our fall course closure, we also completed our annual solid-tine aerification and slit-seeding of the greens, continuing the same process we used successfully last year. We seeded new bentgrass in two directions across all putting surfaces to maximize coverage and establishment. The goal is to encourage desirable bentgrass to fill in and gradually choke out less desirable poa annua. Bentgrass is also more heat and drought tolerant than poa, making it a valuable addition to the long-term health and consistency of our greens.

Although the greens and No. 1 fairway need some time to fully recover, the timing of these projects was planned carefully around the fall golf calendar. With favorable September growing conditions, we expect both areas to recover well ahead of Member/Guest. We appreciate everyone's patience and support as we continue investing in the long-term health, quality, and playability of Sleepy Hollow Golf Club.
